The meaning of 'good sound'


According to IKEA designer, Andreas Fredriksson, the speaker was inspired by the idea: "furnishing your home with sound".




In sync with your home

The SYMFONISK picture frame with WiFi speaker is designed to blend seamlessly into your home. It comes with a magnetic hook so you can hang it horizontally or vertically. It also has rubber feet so you can stand the speaker on a table, shelf or even on the floor – like a sculpture but with sound.








At your fingertips

The SYMFONISK picture frame speaker connects over WiFi so you can create the sound system you want in your home. Simply plug in your speaker to the power outlet, download the SONOS S2 app and follow the step-by-step instructions. The sound is controlled through the app.



Visualising sound

For the artwork on the black and white speaker fronts, artist Jennifer Idrizi was inspired by cymatics – the study of visual sound vibrations. The result is a hypnotic pattern that fades in and out from the centre to the corners. The design interprets the flow of sound as a meditative, abstract pattern. It is made to appeal to a wide variety of tastes.
